Chacra La Papay is the name of our vineyard, and therefore, this line of wines directly presents the clear and elegant aromatic expression of our wines, with soft and balanced tannins that contribute to the right structure.

Malma is a term native to Patagonia, meaning pride. Pride in the journey taken and in what has been accomplished. Bodega Malma, owned by the Viola family, pioneers in viticulture in San Patricio del Chañar, honors its name by filling us with pride with wines that reflect the terroir and the care we put into them.



VINEYARD

Region: San Patricio Del Chañar Argentine Patagonia.

Latitude: 39° South latitude.

Climate: Wide temperature range. Low ambient humidity, constant winds, and scarce precipitation.

Soil Type and Composition: Modern river terrace. Sandy and clayey soils, well-drained with coarse fragments in depth.

WINEMAKING

Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir.

Fermentation: 14 days, traditional with controlled temperature at 20-22°C.

Aging: 100% in stainless steel tanks.

TASTING NOTES

Color: Attractive cherry red.

Aroma: Expressive, highlighting aromas of red fruits such as strawberries and cherries.

Palate: Fresh, round, and balanced palate. A wine with clear, agile flavors, easy to drink.
